Sadly, we cannot hold our usual acts of remembrance at the Memorial Gardens this year but I and the church family want to encourage you to remember in a different way.

- You are invited to join us for a Zoom service on Sunday 8th November at 10:30 (details for the link will be found on the Henham, Elsenham and Ugley church website).

This service will consist of a Remembrance Sunday address from Brigadier Ian Dobbie, a retired army officer, followed by some prayers for our communities, Carver Barracks and service men and women past and present. At 11:00 we will hold an act of remembrance by encouraging you to come and stand on your door steps to observe a two minute silence. We will screen-share a recording of the last post and reveille.

- We also encourage you to make a poppy and display it in your windows or front gardens (those of you with children could make a poppy with them).
- Also we and the Parish Council encourage those organisations that usually lay wreaths at the Memorial Cross on Armistice Day and on the Saturday before Remembrance Sunday to do so at their convenience being careful to observe the rules about social distancing.
