The Memorial Hall continues to play an important role in the life of Elsenham and surrounding Villages, with Groups meeting on every day of the week. We continue to produce the Village Magazine "Elsenham News" which is produced by volunteers and delivered free to each household in the village each month (except January). Elsenham News continues to be funded by advertising receipts. The ECA website is now well established. We have continued to be supported by our District Councillors who have used funds at their discretion to support the ECA and Village Fete. The Village Fete and Craft Fair and Village Santa continue to be run for the benefit of the Village and proceeds are donated to the ECA.
